



## Summer Camp 2013

Children are evaluated on the basis of readiness for our programs. All-Star Academy welcomes all qualified individuals regardless of sex, race, color, creed, disability, and national or ethnic origin.

Enrollment is treated on a first come first served basis this summer, due to limited space.

### 1. Daily Tuition

Half Day: 8am-12pm	\$125/week, \$25/day (with sport)
Half Day: 8am-12pm or 12:30pm-3pm or 3pm- 6:30pm	\$110/week, \$22/day (without sport, on-site activities)
Short Day: 8am-3pm	\$190/week, \$38/day (with sport)
Short Day: 8am-3pm or 12:30pm-6:30pm	\$160/week, \$33/day (without sport, on-site activities)
Full Day 8:00 am – 6:30 pm	\$225/week, \$45/day (with sport)
Full Day 8:00 am – 6:30 pm	\$195/week, \$40/day (without sport, on-site activities)

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### 5. Registration and Material Fee

- \$50 Registration Fee for new students only.
- \$50 Material Fee is for each registered student for all supplies.

### 6. Discounts

- Enroll 8 **FULL** weeks of Full Day program to get the week of 7/1-7/5 for FREE (no program on 7/4)
- Get \$50 credit for a minimum of 6 FULL weeks of Full Day program of enrollment for each referral you make.
- Get 5% off for early registration by April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2013.
- Get 5% Sibling Discount

### 7. Payment terms

- Full payment with registration is required in order to receive discounts.
- Payment is due at registration for **the first five** weeks.
- For **the last four weeks** enrollment, the \$200 non-refundable deposit is required at registration to secure the spots. The \$200 deposit can only be applied to the last payment.
- Payment is due no later than July 12<sup>th</sup>, 2013 for **the last four weeks**.
- It is the responsibility of the parents to fill-out the schedule and make payment due by these dates.
- A \$25 late fee will be assessed for any late payment received in 5 business days past due.
- Enrollment will be cancelled if no payment received in 5 business days past due.

**8. Refunds** - The registration fee, material fee, tuition and deposit are not refundable under any circumstance.

### 9. Absence and credits

Tuition is non-refundable, non-transferable, but **3 day maximum** credit will be given to you if you send us an email 24 hours before the scheduled time. A credit voucher will be issued for each absence. This particular voucher can only be redeemed towards full day program 2013 in Fall Semester.

### 10. Pick up procedure and late pick-up

Parent or authorized personnel are allowed to pick up your children anytime during our business hours. The signature and the sign out time are required on the daily Sign in/Out Sheet. Parents should wait at the front while All-Star staff dismisses your children from their classroom before 5:30pm. Parents should go to the waiting room to meet your kids from 5:30-6:30pm.

Late pick -up (after 6:30pm) will incur a \$15 charge for every 15-minute interval at each occurrence. The After Hour Care will be available upon request. Please contact us and check the applicable fee.

### 11. A Sick Child

You should keep your child home if he/she is sick in order to keep the other children and teachers healthy. If your child has a fever of 100 degrees or above they should not attend All-Star until they have been fever free for 24 hours. If your child becomes ill while attending All-Star you will be called. Your child will need to be picked up promptly.

### 12. Snack and Water

It is the responsibility of parents to prepare enough snacks and water for your child. Please remind your child not to share food with others to eliminate the risk from food allergies.

If you will be buying lunch from All-Star please be sure to pick up our menu for the day. Lunch is \$5 daily and \$20 weekly.
